

School Fees for 2021

Enrolment Fees

Payable on lodging an initial enrolment application	
Enrolment application fee (per learner)	\$50
Enrolment bond (per family) – refundable	\$250

Enrolment application fee: non-refundable and covers the administrative cost of processing each application. Applications cannot be processed until this fee is received.

Enrolment bond: refundable in full when the last learner in the family leaves the school, provided all outstanding financial obligations have been met. Payment of this bond is taken to be acceptance of an offer of enrolment at the school. It is a condition of any enrolment offer that this bond be paid prior to your child commencing their first day at MIS. Non-payment may result in an offer of enrolment being withdrawn.

Annual Fees and Charges

Tuition fees and levies are billed at the end of each new term and are payable by the first day of each term (or last day of each term if a payment plan is in place).

Resource levy: This levy is charged to cover all compulsory workbook items, the school's IT program, subject costs, photocopying, non-subject specific classroom consumables, learner accident and insurance premiums. It excludes some costs that are charged on a user-pay basis e.g. some excursions, individual and group creative arts tuition costs and bus fares. In addition, this levy does not include the basic stationery contained in the Stationery List that is provided in the Enrolment Package.

Building levy: This levy is a compulsory contribution that is non-tax deductible. This contribution is to provide for the maintenance of the school's buildings.

Sibling Discount

Families with more than one child enrolled are eligible for a discount of the Tuition Fee only of 15%, 25% and 50% respectively for the 2nd, 3rd and 4th child. Families in receipt of a bursary are not eligible for the sibling discount.

Personalised Learning Costs

Annual tuition fees and levies cover our core and essential learning programs, which includes all learning areas required to deliver the Australian Curriculum. Costs that arise in the development

of a learner's personal project or personalised learning pathway that sit outside these areas are a family's responsibility. These costs may include:

- a course or other activity provided by an external supplier
- an external exam or assessment that incurs additional costs
- specialised materials or resources
- transport to and from a mentor, training or learning opportunity.

We do not make financial decisions arising from personal projects on behalf of families. The decisions and payment arrangements for these costs are left with the family; however, we are happy to discuss.

Note: All fees must be paid in full by 5 November 2021.

Option 1 One-off yearly payment	Pay the total amount owing via direct deposit by 27 Jan 2021. A \$200 discount per learner is offered for this option.
Option 2 Per term payments	Pay your fees in four (4) instalments of \$988.75 on the first day of every term.
Option 3 Fortnightly payment-plan	Enter into a direct debit agreement to pay 20 fortnightly instalments of \$197.75, beginning 27 Jan 2021 and ending 5 November 2021.
Having difficulty paying	Please contact our Principal if you are having difficulty paying.

Please note, school fees increase around 3% every year.

Terms of Payment

- Fees outstanding after the due date or missed payments on payment plans will incur a \$50 late fee for every week missed.
- All fees must be up-to-date for a learner to attend the school camp.
- Enrolments are suspended for accounts in arrears of their payment agreements at the end of every term.
- A full term's notice in writing is required for any changes to a learner's attendance. Failure to give a term's notice will result in you being invoiced for one term's fees and your Enrolment Bond will be credited against this.
- Should a learner be expelled or suspended from school the current term's fees remain payable.
